How Does the CoolTouch Laser Work?

The CoolTouch CT3Plus CoolBreeze produces 1320nm laser light energy that is specifically absorbed by water and water associated with collagen. Collagen is a major component in the tissues of the nail and nail growth area as well as the skin. The laser is so sophisticated that it can detect and reach the proper target temperature set by Dr. Kahan, leading to death of the fungus. The treatment then stops immediately, and the the nail is cooled with a spray. The CoolTouch CT3 plus zoom is an industry-leading laser that was developed for skin treatment. This is a perfect fit for fungal nails since the nail is simply modified skin. The other current lasers for toenail fungus lack these advanced features and are essentially reworked dental lasers.

How Effective is the Laser?

Current results show at least 80% success.

Is the Treatment Painful? Safe?

The CoolBreeze mode on the CoolTouch laser provides a comfortable safe controlled treatment by cooling the affected areas and closely monitoring the treatment temperature. The CoolBreeze mode provides one of the safest most effective treatments in the laser industry today. In studies to date, there have been no side effects, complications or adverse reactions. How Long Does the Treatment Take?

The treatment takes about 15 minutes for 10 toes. According to research, a single treatment is not the best option for the patient. Dr. Kahan recommends at least 2 treatments; however, treatment plans will be individualized for each patient.

What are the Treatment Costs?

Costs are between \$250 and \$800 depending on the number of toes infected and the severity of the infection. This cost includes two treatments, 2 months apart. If Dr. Kahan determines that you need a 3rd treatment, the decision will be made after 6 months. If required, the treatment will be no cost.

How Soon Will I See Improvement?

On average, a toenail will replace itself every 9-12 months. Healthy new growth will be visible within the first 2 months as your nails continue to grow following the laser treatment.
